



We are a free public charter school serving children living in San Francisco's highest-poverty neighborhoods. Our mission is to disrupt the cycle of poverty by preparing students to go to and graduate from college.



### OnePurpose School

- 180 students in transitional kindergarten to grade 4 this year:
  - 90% qualify for free or reduced lunch
  - 54% African-American, 40% Latino, 6% Asian/Pacific Islander or Other
  - 30% English Language Learners
- Located in the Bayview
- Opened in August 2015
- Will grow one grade per year through grade 12
- Admission by random lottery



### Demographics of the Bayview

- 82% of children live in poverty.
- Historically, fewer than 10% of students graduate college.

### 2017–2018 Results

- 60% of our students read at or above grade level based on our internal literacy assessments, above the norm for students living in poverty.
- We provided individual and small group therapy to 25% of our students, which helped increase student attentiveness and decrease disruptive behavior.
- Student attendance was a strong 93%.
- 95% of students re-enrolled for this school year.
- We did not expel or counsel out a single student for the third straight year.
- We invested more than \$7,500 in private philanthropy per student.



### Our Pioneering Model

- We offer a progressive college preparatory program with high behavioral and academic expectations, delivered with love.
- The pillars of our model include: addressing trauma head-on, a deep focus on literacy and higher order thinking skills, project-based learning and strong parent involvement.


### Additional Information

- 9:1 student to faculty ratio
- 58% faculty of color
- Two full-time onsite therapists
- Partnerships:
  - Seneca Family of Agencies provides literacy intervention and socio-emotional support services.
  - The Boys & Girls Club of San Francisco provides our free before and after school program.
  - Five Keys provides parenting and ESL classes to our parents.
  - The YMCA provides our summer program.


### Financial Overview
