

We are a free public charter school serving children living in San Francisco's highest-poverty neighborhoods. Our mission is to disrupt the cycle of poverty by preparing students to go to and graduate from college.



### **OnePurpose School**

- Approximately 130 students in kindergarten to grade 4 this year:
  - 90% qualify for free or reduced lunch
  - 54% African-American, 40% Latino, 6% Asian/Pacific Islander or Other
  - 30% English Language Learners
- Located in the Bayview neighborhood of San Francisco
- Opened in August 2015
- Admission by random lottery

### **Demographics of the Bayview**

- 82% of children live in poverty.
- Historically, fewer than 10% of students graduate college.

### **2017–2018 Results**

- 60% of our students read at or above grade level based on our internal literacy assessments, above the norm for students living in poverty.
- We provided individual and small group therapy to 25% of our students, which helped increase student attentiveness and decrease behaviors that impede learning.
- Student attendance was a strong 93%.
- We did not expel or counsel out a single student for the third straight year.
- We invested more than \$7,500 in private philanthropy per student.

### **Our Pioneering Model**

- We offer a progressive college preparatory program with high behavioral and academic expectations, delivered with love.
- The pillars of our model include addressing trauma head-on, a deep focus on literacy and higher order thinking skills, project-based learning and strong parent involvement.

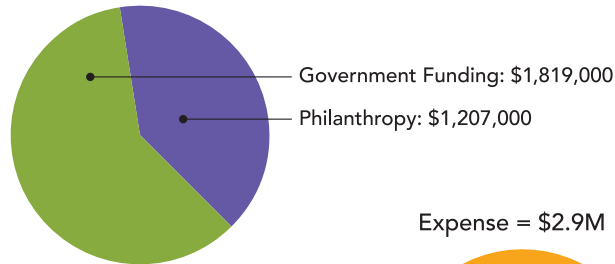
### Additional Information

- 7:1 student to faculty ratio
- 70% faculty of color

  - Five Keys provides parenting and ESL classes to our parents.
  - The YMCA provides our summer program.

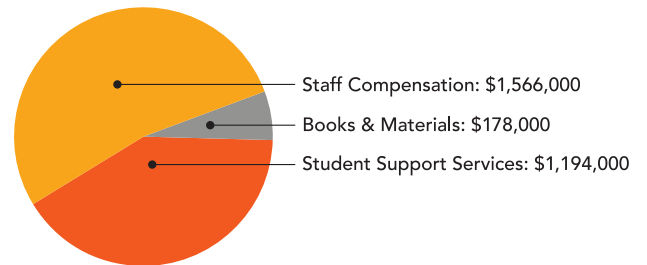
### Financial Overview
